WELCOME TO HAWTHORN



We have three properties available on a working croft delightfully situated in a peaceful rural area five minutes from the beach. We are one mile from the village of Benderloch with its small church, well-stocked general store and post office, garage and coffee shop. There is also a small licensed restaurant on the premises. Bed linen is included in the rental, electric meter read at the end of your stay. Parking is available. Dogs must be kept under strict control and you must clean up after them.



THE BARN

This is a 19th century barn comfortably converted to provide excellent facilities.

It has a bright and cosy open plan lounge, kitchen with fridge, cooker, microwave, washing machine, coffee maker and toaster. There is a colour TV, Video and an electric fire in the lounge area.



One double and one twin bedroom each with wash hand basins and shaver points. The shower room also contains toilet and wash hand basin.

Panel heaters provide heating.

THE STABLE

This is a newly built wooden lodge fitted out to a high standard. A tastefully decorated and comfortable lounge with a colour TV, Video and an electric fire provide a pleasant homely atmosphere. A large window outlooks over the fields towards Ardmucknish Bay. The small kitchen is fully equipped with a fridge, cooker, microwave, toaster, washing machine, crockery and cutlery. The bathroom includes a toilet, shower and wash hand basin.



There is one double room and a twin room warmed by panel heaters.



THE STEADING

A luxurious chalet home in an idyllic situation with views to Ben Lora and more distant vistas. It sits in its own fenced ground and has a sunny patio. The Steading has been tastefully decorated and colour coordinated. Inside there is one double and one twin bedroom, bath and shower.



The kitchen is fully fitted with cooker, microwave, washing machine, kettle, toaster, crockery and cutlery. The lounge has a pair of two-seater settees, colour TV/video and a fire. There is gas fired central heating throughout and for those resting moments an ample supply of books and videos.

INFORMATION about the area which we hope will be useful. Benderloch has a General store and Post Office, Petrol and Garage repair, Outdoor Leisure shop, a Restaurant at Hawthorn and the Ben Lora Cafe; St. Modan's Church of Scotland,

Kintaline Garden centre; facilities for charter Fishing, Diving and Karting (in season). A mobile bank visits Benderloch every Wednesday; the last post is uplifted about 3.30pm. Benderloch village hall holds events all year round.

Eight miles south of Hawthorn is the town of Oban, the "Gateway" to the islands. The Isle of Mull is only 45 minutes by ferry from Oban, so on a day trip, you can explore the island, visit the Abbey at Iona or take a trip out to Staffa and Fingal's Cave. The islands of Kerrera and Lismore are ideal There are many places to visit close to Hawthorn - Dunstaffnage Castle, The Falls of Lora, the historic Bonawe Iron Furnace, Cruachan Power Station (the Hollow Mountain), Oban Distillery, the Rare Breeds Park, McCaig's Tower and Dunollie Castle. Gardens open to the public - Achnacloich, near Taynuilt, Ardchattan Priory, on Loch Etive, and Druimavaric at the head of Loch Creran. Highland Games are held at several venues. Evening entertainment ranges from Ceilidhs in local pubs to eating out - locally caught fish being a particular delicacy!


